WEEK 1

God asks us to help each other. 2 Kings 4:1–7; Galatians 6:1–10

So what's your next step? Is there something you need help with? How can you help your friends, family, and loved ones? How can you be more connected to the things your community needs? Whatever your next step is right now, take it.

WEEK 2 God can do impossible things. 2 Kings 4:8–37; Colossians 1:3–14



Take a moment to read the passages we're covering this week. What stands out to you in this passage and why?



This week, ask God to help you with a situation that seems impossible.



So what's your next step? Who can help remind you that God does the impossible? How can you help someone remember God can do impossible things? Can you share stories from your life where God did something that seemed impossible? Whatever your next step is right now, take it.



WEEK 3 God helps us solve big problems. 2 Kings 4:38–44; Psalm 52:8–9



Take a moment to read the passages we're covering this week. What stands out to you in this passage and why?



This week, thank God for helping you with a problem you experienced recently.



So what's your next step? Who are the people who help you whenever you have a problem? Can you help show someone how God solves problems? What solutions can you help bring to the problems your community faces? Whatever your next step is right now, take it.

WEEK 4 God gives us more than we can imagine. 2 Kings 5:1–14; Luke 11:1-13



Take a moment to read the passages we're covering this week. What stands out to you in this passage and why?



This week, thank God for giving you so much more than you could imagine.



So what's your next step? Is there a situation where you've been expecting God to respond in a specific way? How can you be more open to God's guidance? Can you start a conversation about the ways you have seen God give you more than you expected? Whatever your next step is right now, take it.
