



Sermon-based small groups connect the week to the weekend!

Dig deeper into the talk each week, while getting connected, cared for and known. Challenge yourself to see how the message actually makes sense and applies to your everyday life and do it with people just like you to support you on your journey.

Message Info: Don't Wanna Miss It, 3/28/21 - It is easy to lose things in translation. We get caught up in the buzz of the right now, what we need right now, what life looks like right now and we miss what God is doing in our lives. That is why it so important to go to the source and the source is Jesus. He's whats missing when we miss peace and hope and joy. (Passages: John 12:12-19; John 3:1-21; Luke 19:41-42)

Discussion Questions: Take your time and dig into these questions.

Do you have a story funny or serious about a time when something got lost and translation? Could you share it with the group?

Wave you ever heard something that caused you to experience hurt or confusion that could have been avoided by getting to the source of what you had heard? What happened?

Read John 12:12-19 and Luke 19:28-44 while noting the different highlights from each passage. What sticks out to you from either passages? Why do you think that sticks out to you?

Sneaky Seeking Nicodemus went to the source in John 3, and asked the right questions in the right place. What are some wrong places to go to for the answers to your biggest questions? Why are they not great?

What would you ask Jesus right now if you could spend a few moments with Him?

What's a practical way you can practice connecting to the source (Jesus) this week?

How can you practice listening to God during this Easter season?

Group Challenge: Do a serve project as a group. It could be a project at church, one of our locations, or in the community. Keep is simple and easy. Just serve to show love.
