**Message Info:** #Salty, 5/30/2021- The next message in our #BLESSED series focuses on the commands that Jesus gave us to be salt and light in our world. We may not realize this, but ANYONE can make an impact; we all have purpose. We need to live in our uniqueness and be an enhancement. We cannot keep our faith to ourselves, but we need to be a light exposing the darkness in the world. Most importantly, we are to do these things so that we can lead others to God and ultimately glorify Him through it all. You can make an IMPACT! (*Passages: Matthew 5:13-16, Colossians 4:6, Daniel 3:1-30, Ephesians 6:11-12*)

**Discussion Questions:** Take your time and dig into these questions.

Was there ever a situation or moment in your life where you thought something you did would not be impactful at all, but it actually was?

Why might some people think that they cannot make an impact? Why might some people think that they do not have a purpose for being here?

Read Matthew 5:13-16. What are some questions that come to your mind as you read through this passage?

Being a salt of the earth looks like living in our uniqueness and not going through the motions. How has God made you unique? What has He gifted you at? What are you passionate about? What do you LOVE to do?

Read Colossians 4:6. Salt enhances flavor, and we are called to be that enhancement within our relationships. How can we make sure that our conversations are wholesome and helpful?

Being a light means NOT being a private Christian. Why is this a hard thing to do? Why is it an important thing to do?

How can you be light? How can you strive to make a difference and make an impact?

**Group Challenge:** Discover one way you can be a light within your home, school, workplace, relationships, etc., and make that application and be a light.
