



Sermon-based small groups connect the week to the weekend!

Dig deeper into the talk each week, while getting connected, cared for and known. Challenge yourself to see how the message actually makes sense and applies to your everyday life and do it with people just like you to support you on your journey.

Message Info: Triggered - 4/18/21- Waiting for anything is hard. It's especially hard when waiting for matters of the heart. This message looks at the last encounter between the disciples and Jesus recorded in the book of John. Don't fall back into what is comfortable or busy when you get restless. Look back and see how far God has brought you. Let your past trigger grace and reframe your future. God loves you and new beginnings await. *(Passages: John 21:1-22)*

Discussion Questions: Take your time and dig into these questions.

What is the most challenging or funniest experience you ever had waiting for something?

What are some things you fall back to when you are feeling restless and sick of waiting?
What about those things distracts you?

Read John 21:1-22 together. (Take turns, it's a long chapter.) What's your favorite part of this story? Why did you pick that part?

Can you think of a failure or frustration that at the time was a bummer but now was a blessing? If so can you tell us that story?

Read Romans 8:28 - What is one way this verse could apply to what was going on in John chapter 21?

What are some ways you practice letting your past trigger grace?

What is one way this week you feel like God is leading you to follow Him in?
