



Sermon-based small groups connect the week to the weekend!

Dig deeper into the talk each week, while getting connected, cared for and known. Challenge yourself to see how the message actually makes sense and applies to your everyday life and do it with people just like you to support you on your journey.

Message Info: About Love, 7/31/22 - Love will make you do some crazy things. It is the best motivator and it is what is most transformative. That's why it is so sad that so many people who believe in God don't really know His love for us. It's a crazy love that Jesus describes to us in this passage. We aren't motivated by religious ritual, obligation or a sense of duty we are motivated by God's incredible love for us. (*Passages: John 15:9-17, Luke 7:36-50, Galatians 6:2*)

Discussion Questions: Take your time and dig into these questions.

Did you ever do something silly or crazy or out of character because of love? Can you share that story here?

Of all the motivators do you think love is the greatest? Why or why not?

Read John 15:9-17. What sticks out to you and why does it stick out?

What does this passage say about the Love Jesus has for us? If you had to describe it with one word how would you describe it? Why did you pick that word?

No one likes being told what to do. We are used to people having an angle when they tell us what to do. According to this passage what is Jesus' angle or goal for us? What are your thoughts about that goal?

Read Luke 7:36-50. What sticks out to you about the two characters in this passage? How are these people two pictures of what motivates us?

Why is Jesus' love the greatest according to these passages?

Read Galatians 6:2. What is one way you can live this verse out a little better this week?

Group Challenge: Spend some time journaling about the love of God and how you have been experiencing it this week. Share this exercise and your thoughts with a trusted group member or friend.
